## ENTRY FEES

Conformation and Obedience Entry Fees include \$.50 AKC Recording Fee on First Entry and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on Each Entry. Each Rally. Entry includes \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee. If the same dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry. Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in U. S. Funds. **TABULATE CAREFULLY.** Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$10 will be made. Each First Entry in Conformation (unless otherwise specified). . . . . \$30.00 Each additional entry of the same dog (also Brace as a unit). . . . . \$25.00 Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. & 9-12 mos. only) & Bred by Exhibitor Classes. \$25.00 Obedience Classes. . . . . Original Entry \$30.00 / Additional Entry - \$25.00 Rally Classes. . . . . First Entry - \$30.00 / Additional Entry - \$25.00 Sweepstakes Classes (MUST ALSO be entered in a regular class). . . . . \$25.00 Veteran Sweepstakes Classes (NEED NOT be entered in a regular class) \$25.00 Junior Showmanship. . . . . NOTE: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There are no Recording Fees or Event Services Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.) An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

#### Amateur Owner Handler (AOH) Class Eligibility

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows  
"The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs Bred by Exhibitor Bitches

#### Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or coowned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

### SPECIAL COMPETITION

#### BEST BRINDLE

Open to any brindle competing in Regular Classes, not defeated by another brindle. Open to Highest Placing Brindle in each class. If no placing brindles in class, then all brindles in class are then eligible.

#### BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR CLASSES

#### BEST VETERAN

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Brindle or Best Puppy competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one or more of the above.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male

may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**\*Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only

to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes

or Best of Breed. Entry Fee: Stud Dog Only - \$29.00. Stud Dog as an additional class \$24.00.

**\*Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

**Brace Class** - For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than one handler. Both dogs must be entered in another class. The entry fee is \$24.00 as an additional entry for the Brace as a UNIT. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

### **AWARD OF MERIT**

The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring up to five (5) Bullmastiffs (including Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed) to receive a Neck Medallion. These Medallions are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

### **OBEDIENCE TRIAL**

For Bullmastiffs Only. No move-ups will be accepted at this trial. "Dog" means either sex. No refund for bitches in season. Qualifying score required for all prizes in regular classes.

#### **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP**

**Novice Junior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class** - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Intermediate Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Senior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Master Class** - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776 or email juniors@akc.org.

Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family or by an amateur handler with exception that

professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense, and all prize money is the property of the owner.

Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.
